



You Are Invited: Trent Hills Transit Official Launch

April 29th, 2019 (Trent Hills)

Community Care Northumberland in partnership with the Municipality of Trent Hills will be launching a municipal transit pilot project on Monday April 29th. The service will start from the town of Hastings in front of the Hastings Civic Centre for 8:03am.

The official ribbon cutting launch will be on Wednesday, May 15th, 2019 at 7:30 am in Hastings.

“Our team will be there to meet local residents and share the excitement of this new municipal system,” said Anne Newman – Regional Transportation Coordinator. “As per the schedule, this route will travel between Hastings, Warkworth and Campbellford and allow for multiple stops through cheaper fares and day/monthly pass options. Residents of Trent Hills will have the opportunity to travel between or within towns with service running four times daily.”
